- Redtail is 164 acres, owned by City of Portland, in Washington County
- Redtail is surrounded by approximately 2/3 homes
- Other possible sites: Lloyd Center, NW Portland River Front
- Housing & hotels are included in development plans
- Stadium would hold 50K to 60K people
- Stats: Portland is ranked 4<sup>th</sup> most likely location by a sportsbook
- Property sale price of \$50 million = \$100K per quarter acre
- Expansion team purchase cost: approximately \$2.2 Billion

- One of few public golf courses in area: used by high school and club teams
- Local housing may be purchased by investors for short-term rentals
